The success of last year's Year 11 students is a testament to their hard work and that of the staff at the school

Since my arrival in September 2006 as Headteacher, the school has focused on maintaining its warm, friendly atmosphere whilst pursuing an improvement trend in academic performance. This is part of our aim of becoming a high-performing school through our Leading Learning Community ethos.

Each year the school is set performance targets by the Local Authority and DCSF. There are two levels:

- FFT B which is based on that year group's predicted ability on entry to the school
- FFT D which is based on the performance by the top 25% of schools in the country
- FFT is short for the Fischer Family Trust, an organisation which generates the target levels for schools which are used by the Local Authority and DCSF.

I am extremely proud to announce the 2009 Key Stage 4 examination results for The Grange School and Sports College:

- 5 A*-C - 62% (FFT D Target 61%)
- 5 A*-C with English & Maths - 40% (FFT B Target 41%)
- 5 A*-G - 96% (FFT D Target 93%)
- Average points score per student - 470 (FFT D Target 378)

The success of last year's Year 11 students is a testament to their hard work and that of the staff at the school. The wide range of qualifications on offer (GCSE, BTEC, OCR Nationals and Diplomas) enables every student to follow courses best suited to their ability and interests.
